SCAM PREVENTION TIPS

Scams are everywhere. Here are a few tips to help avoid them!

1. Don't click on links from an unknown or unsolicited email source.
2. Before making online purchases, ensure the company is legitimate. Visit bbb.org to verify the company's credibility and read the reviews.
3. When buying online, ensure that the website has "https" in the URL, along with a small lock icon on the address bar.
4. If someone has contacted you, never share your personal information!
5. If you are on social media, be sure to use the privacy settings which limit the amount of information that is shared with whom.
6. When caller ID shows a call coming from an 'unknown caller', let it ring!
7. Local phone scammers often use software to mask their identities by displaying a fake telephone number. In fact, sometimes the number the scammer uses already belongs to a real person. There is no fool-proof way to avoid these scammers, unless you let all calls go to voicemail.
